We have reviewed the accompanying statement of unaudited financial results ("the Statement") of M/s. Eastern Dooars Tea Company Limited ("the Company") for the quarter ended 30th June, 2023 being submitted by the company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("the Regulations").
